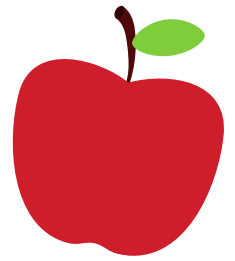


2020-21 School Year Nutrition



The last day of our summer meals program is Monday, August 31.

Beginning on Tuesday, September 1, important changes are coming to our Child Nutrition Hubs. Due to current federal child nutrition guidelines, we are required to serve only students who are enrolled in Lee County Schools. We are also adding distribution sites and eliminating community drop-offs.

Nine food distribution sites will open for curbside pickup only beginning September 1. **Student ID numbers for each meal must be provided at meal distribution.** A breakfast and lunch will be provided at pickup, and only one (1) pickup per day per student is allowed. Households may pick up meals for all students in their households at one pickup location, which can be picked up at any of the sites listed below. All Lee County Schools students are encouraged to participate.

All meals served during remote learning are at no cost to the household.

Pick up available 8 a.m.-9 a.m., 11 a.m.-1 p.m., and 5 p.m.-6 p.m.
