**New Social Studies Course: Economics and Personal Finance**

- State continues to work on the new social studies course: Economics and Personal Finance (EPF) which is a graduation requirement for the class entering in 2021-2022
  - Any certified teacher can teach the course as long as they are not paid from CTE funds and have attended the EPF professional development
  - The state is still in development stages for professional development and this should take place later this school year.

  - ACT Reading Benchmark score of 22 OR
  - SAT Reading Benchmark of 480
