



Curriculum Manager: Editing, Copying, & Deleting Materials Quick Reference Card

To Edit a Single Material

 Use the filters to locate the material you want to edit. Click View Results to apply the filters. Select the material you want to edit from the results list by checking the box next to the name of the material. Click Edit at the top of the list.



2. The material light box will pop up, giving you access to all the tabs for the material you selected.



Editing Multiple Materials

Editing multiple materials allows you to make mass changes to any of the fields on the **Properties** tab at once. For instance, you might change the Author, Publisher, or Grade Range for a set of materials.


- 1. Locate the materials you wish to edit by using the available filters, clicking the checkboxes next to the names of the desired materials, and click **Edit**.
- 2. The light box which pops up will display the blank **Properties** tab. You can make changes to any of the fields



on this tab and apply these changes to all the selected materials.

Click **Save** once you have made all your changes.






2. The copied materials will have the same name as the original with the addition of the word (Copy), (Copy 2), (Copy 3), etc. Select a copy to edit it and change the Title and Description fields.

Deleting Materials

1. Select the material you want to delete by clicking the box next to the material name. Click **Delete.**




2. A warning message appears. Click **OK** to permanently delete this material from the District Materials Bank.

Copying Materials


The copy feature is helpful if you want to quickly create shells for the same material type. For instance, need to create 6 Instructional Units for Mathematics Grade 5. Since most of the fields on the properties tab with be the same (subject, grade, author, publisher), you can easily and efficiently create one unit, copy it, and then edit the Title and Description fields of each copy.

1. Select the material you want to copy by clicking the box next to the material name. Click **Copy**.

You will see confirmation that a material has been deleted at the top of the materials list.



Note: If you would like to remove a material from the District bank without deleting it, you can simply change the status on the material from Active to Draft.
