



Share to Classroom with Chrome

You can use the [Share to Classroom Chrome extension](#) to share web content to your classes in three ways: instantly push webpages to all students in a class, create an assignment, or create an announcement. Your students and co-teachers must have the extension enabled to share content with them.

Share a webpage to Classroom

1. In Chrome, navigate to the website you want to share and click  next to the address bar.
2. Sign in with your Google Apps for Education account.
3. Click the name of the class you want to share with.
4. (Optional) If you haven't created any classes, you'll get an error message. Click **Open Classroom** to create a class.
5. Select one of the following options:
 - To share a webpage, click **Push to students** > **Push**. The webpage instantly appears in the browsers of all active students and co-teachers in the class.
 - To create an announcement, click **Make announcement**, enter your announcement, see [Post an announcement](#) for additional options, and click **Post**.
 - To share an assignment, click **Create assignment**, then create your assignment, see [Create an assignment](#) for additional options, and click **Assign**.
6. (Optional) Click **View** to view the announcement or assignment in the class stream.

View websites that were recently shared

1. In Chrome, click  next to the address bar.
2. Verify **Push to students** is selected.
3. To view webpages that you recently pushed, select **Pushed to students**.
4. To view webpages the students recently pushed to you, select **Received from students**.
