

Attention All Juniors



It is a requirement of all Southern Lee students and all juniors in North Carolina to take the ACT. You will be taking the ACT in person on **Tuesday, February 23, 2021**. Additional information about the test day will be provided at a later date. Lee County Schools does it's best to prepare all juniors for the ACT by conducting an ACT Boot Camp. Southern Lee's Boot Camp will be held virtually from **February 9-16**. Each junior is required to attend one day of boot camp instruction. You will be receiving your attendance date and google meets link in the next few days. The boot camp lasts for one school day. You will not be counted absent from your daily classes if you attend the boot camp.

In order to be fully prepared for the boot camp you will need to pick up an ACT Boot Camp Workbook. If you picked up your report card on January 20th or 21st you should have been given a workbook. If you did not pick up your report card then you may pick up your work book on **Wednesday, February 3** from **11:30 am - 1:00 pm** or from **3:00 pm - 6:00 pm**. Should you not be able to pick up your work book you are still eligible to attend the boot camp; however, it is highly encouraged that you make every effort to pick up a work book.



Ms. Salter will be emailing you a link and password to join the ACT Boot Camp with MasteryPrep. Be sure to open and save this email!

You will also be receiving information for you to complete via Google Form concerning your ACT transportation needs. You should receive that form the first week on February. Please check your student email account regularly until you have taken the ACT on February 23, 2021, to ensure you understand any and all requirements you need to meet concerning the ACT.
