

Metals II Course Overview

Semester Class

Block: 90 minutes

Course Description:

In this course, which is 18 weeks, (1 semester) and 1 credit earned upon passing the course. Students will learn how to locate, secure, keep and change careers. With emphasis placed on self assessment of the students characteristics, interest and individual values. Students will explore different types of careers and educational avenues. Evaluate career information and create a career plan. This course is based on the national career development guidelines. Skills learned in this course include but are not limited to communications, interpersonal skills, problem solving, personal mgmt and teamwork. This course can assist and strengthen students preparing for jobs, competitive events, community service and leadership activity thru the essential standards and skills learned in this course.

Test

Tests will be at least 1 online each week. At the end of the course students will take a final online test.
