## DIRECTIONS

1. Create an 8.5 x 11 inch poster on any type of paper about recycling, conservation or taking care of the earth using crayons, chalk, pen/ink, watercolor, markers, or colored pencils. Words and numbers can be used. Your artwork should convince the judges that recycling, conservation, and taking care of the Earth is necessary and helpful. All artwork must be original. Any artwork copied, traced or printed will be disqualified. All artwork must be 2D (no clay or sculptures). Only one entry per student.
2. Write your name, grade, school and homeroom teacher's name on the BACK of your artwork.
3. Place your artwork in the EARTH DAY CONTEST BOX at your school office on or before April 3, 2017. No late submissions can be accepted.
4. Winners will be notified by April 14, 2017. Sorry, but artwork will not be returned. All decisions of the judges are final.
